KW-FIELD TO BE USED ON 5.3 MILLION SQFT OF VA (VETERANS AFFAIRS) HOSPITALS

The kWhOURS touchscreen field software streamlines the process of data collection and data management for the VA

kW-Field is a software package designed for a touch-screen tablet PC. The customizable program allows an engineer to include only those factors they want considered in a specific building. The field auditor is then guided by a series of prompts for inputs. The data collected is turned into valuable information that is presented back to the auditor in excel and HTML outputs.

Facility energy system data will be captured by VA contractors in an effort to keep a better digitized inventory of all energy consuming equipment. System data being captured by kW-Field will include, but are not limited to:

- Lighting systems
- Cooling and Distributed HVAC systems
- Motors & Drives
- Ventilation and Evaporation
- Thermal Distribution
- Controls
- Water consumption
- Heating sources
- Domestic hot water

The data collection process began in late September and will be completed over the next few months.
